This usually occurs after transfer and may include recommendations from faculty. Credit will not be given for variable topic courses in Journalism, Photography, Health, Business Administration, Architecture, Administration of Justice (Criminology) or Library Departments due to the credit restrictions in those areas. This policy is effective Fall 2001.

Credit Limitations:

Limitations on the number of units that can be transferred to UC have been removed from Art, Music, and Theater Arts; however, students are cautioned from completing an excessive number of units in these areas. It is expected that students will plan their transfer program carefully and will enroll in general education as well as courses preparatory for their intended major at UC.
